Puly Club Meeting

Our July club meeting will again be both inperson and online. ESSDB Jim will be hosting the meeting at his home at 6:00 PM on Thursday, July 7. Our meeting agenda will include our extensively revised plans for the dive/camp weekend, determining the time for our August club dive at Possession Point Fingers, and selecting a site and time for our October club dive. The last agenda item (for those at the in-person meeting) will be to choose a location for the post-meeting dinner.

Puly Club Dive, Les Davis

For our July club dive we will travel south to Tacoma for a dive at the Les Davis Pier. This dive site is in a park with plenty of parking and nearby facilities. However, it can get busy on a nice summer day. There is a bit of a walk from the parking area to the entry point, but entry is easy and it is not current sensitive. We plan to meet at the site on Sunday, July 17 at 10:00 AM and enter the water at 11:00 AM. The dive site consists of an artificial reef with lots of nooks and crannies to explore. Potential critters include ling cod, rock fish, nudibranchs, and gunnels. Additional critters reported at this site are the Red Brotula, Sail Fin Sculpin, and Grunt Sculpin. After the dive we will head down to the Ram for lunch.

Directions to Les Davis:

Take I-5 to Exit 133 and take I-705 North, toward the City Center.

Stay on I-705 for 1.9 miles and take the Pacific Ave. ramp to your left, toward Schuster Parkway.

Follow Schuster Parkway for 1.5 miles until you see a ramp to the left for N. Ruston Way.

Go left onto N. Ruston Way. Follow N. Ruston Way for about 1.4 miles to the entrance to the park. The entrance is a short distance past the large red fire boat on your right. Park as close to the west end of the parking area (as far from the entrance as you can).

All in all, it was a pleasant day to be out and we can look forward to future dives with less plankton in the water.

ESSDB Richard has offered to host the event at his compound near Hoodsport on September 16-18. Doint Hudson Dive Site

The Point Hudson dive site is located in Port Townsend. This site is generally considered one of the better shore dive sites in the Puget Sound area. Much of the dive consists of exploring the nooks and crannies formed by the boulders at the base of the south jetty, which are home to a large variety of critters including GPOs, wolf eels, gunnels, nudibranchs, and more. The Port of Port Townsend is planning on replacing the south jetty, which will involve removal of the creosote pilings and the boulders. They will be replaced with new steel pilings and boulders. Work is currently projected to begin this coming fall, which will effectively eliminate Point Hudson as a dive site during construction and probably for some time afterwards. Hopefully life will return to the site in a few years to restore the quality of this dive site.
