ay Club Meeting

Our regularly scheduled virtual meeting will be held on Thursday, May 6 at our usual time, 6:00 PM. The Zoom link will be emailed to regular meeting attendees the afternoon before the meeting. The meeting agenda includes final planning for the postponed 2020 Holiday Party and initial planning for a possible 2021 Dive/Camp weekend. We will also plan the August and September club dives.

We will be doing a north side dive for our May club dive, traveling up to Mukilteo. The site has changed a lot since construction of the new ferry dock to the north of the NOAA lab. The old ferry dock was being demolished a couple months ago, and is probably completely gone now. Parking has also changed a bit, but street parking and parking in the lot at the north end of the Silver Cloud is available. We will meet at 1:00 PM on Saturday, May 22. The restrooms at the old ferry terminal are no longer available, but a walk to the park will get you to facilities. We hope to find the geodome and, if we want to go deep, we will look for The Man. After the dive we can get some fish and chips from Ivar's and find a place to enjoy them.

Directions to Mukilteo Tee Dock:

For those coming from south of Mukilteo, head north on I5 to Exit 182 (Highway 525). Turn left at the end of the exit ramp on Hwy 525 (also called Mukilteo Speedway) and continue for about 8 miles. When you get to the waterfront, turn right onto Front St. (in front of Ivar's) and continue north on to the parking areas just north of the Silver Cloud Inn. There is a small parking lot to the left and more parking along Front Street and on the street to the right. There is also parking along Front St. if you turn around. You will need to pay for parking. If you are coming from the north, head south on I5 to Exit 189 (Hwy 526/Boeing Freeway). Turn right and follow the highway past the airport to 84th St. SW. Turn right and continue to
