ctoboo Club Meeting

The club will start Halloween month by holding our Octoboo club meeting at 6:00 PM on **Thursday**, Octoboo 5th. We plan on a virtual meeting using Zoom. Spanky will email an invitation to the regular meeting attendees some time in advance of the meeting time. Our meeting agenda includes planning our February 2024 club dive.

ctoboo Club Dive, Fox Is. Bridge Our Octoboo club dive will be at a site new to most club members, the Fox Island Bridge. This is a current-sensitive dive site that is rich in marine life. Hale Passage is fairly shallow - the maximum depth is probably around 65 feet. Since it is current sensitive, please plan on arriving on time so we can be ready to splash before slack. Our meet time for this dive is 9:15 AM on Saturday, Octoboo 21. We will enter the water no later than 10:15 AM and will check the current before we splash. After the dive we will find a local eatery, probably in Gig harbor, for some lunch and libation.

Directions to Fox Island Bridge:

Take I-5 to Exit 132 (Gig harbor, Bremerton, Hwy 16 West) and follow Hwy 16 across the Tacoma Narrows Bridge. Follow Hwy 16 for 2 miles after crossing the bridge and take the Olympic Drive NW/Fox Island exit. Follow Olympic Dr. over Hwy 16 and onto 56th St. NW, then onto Filmore Dr. NW. When you get to a tee turn left onto Wollochet Dr. NW. In 1.1 mi the road turns to the right and becomes 40th St. NW. Continue for 0.7 mi and turn left onto 70th Ave NW and take it to a second tee where you turn right onto 32nd St. NW. Follow 32nd, which becomes Warren Dr. NW and then Fox Island Bridge Rd., which takes you to the bridge. After you cross the water on the bridge turn right into the parking area for the boat ramp on the Fox Island side. Park and get your gear ready. You can also tell Google Maps to get you to the Fox Island Boat Ramp.
