ctober Club Dive, Possession Pt.

For our October club dive we have selected a site that is new to most of our members. We will be traveling to the southern tip of Whidbey Island to do a dive at the Possession Point Fingers. Our meeting time for this dive is 1:30 PM on Saturday, October 1. This is a current-sensitive site and we need to make special arrangements to obtain access to the beach, so please plan to be on time. This dive is in a State Park, so remember to bring your Discover Pass. Parking is also limited. Depending on how many divers will be going, we may need to shuttle gear between the upper and lower parking areas. If you plan on doing this dive, please RSVP to Spanky via email no later than September 24. We hope to spot some GPO's as well as lots of rockfish, greenlings, and ling cod. After the dive we will to the Village Pizzeria in Langley for dinner.

Directions to Possession Point Fingers:

You can enter Possession Point Dive Site into Google Maps and have it plot your route.

From the Clinton Ferry Terminal:

Head west on Hwy 525. At about 1.5 miles turn left onto Deer Lake Road.

At about 3.2 miles, turn left onto Cultus Bay Rd.

After about 2.1 miles, Cultus Bay Rd. turns to the right but you need to continue straight onto Possession Rd.

Our August club dive at Redondo had a good turnout. We had very pleasant weather for this summer dive but it was a challenge to park with all the other divers there that morning. Visibility was decent for a summer dive - about 15-20 feet once we got below about 40 feet. While we did not get to the remains of the sunken Volkswagen, we did find several different nudibranchs, a couple red octopuses, and a very small wolf eel.

Cool-?-of the Month Section Cool-Web-Articles-Of-The-Month:

This month Spanky found an interesting, but still cool, article about marine fairy circles. These are circular patterns of seaweed in the marine environment and are similar to terrestrial fairy circles which have been extensively studied by scientists. You can probably learn more than you want to know about seaweed fairy circles by clicking on seaweed fairy circles.

Spanky's second article is about using a dolphin-mounted underwater camera to learn about how dolphins hunt and consume their prey. It also documents for the first time that a bottlenose dolphin caught and consumed 8 venomous sea snakes.
